



## How to Use www.ASSIST.org

ASSIST is an online resource that shows how course credits earned at a California Community College will transfer to a CSU or UC. It is critical to use ASSIST to determine what classes to take at SRJC to meet lower division major preparation courses for a UC or CSU.

Start by selecting Santa Rosa Junior College from the drop-down menu

### Welcome to ASSIST

ASSIST is an online student-transfer information system that shows how course credits earned at one public California college or university can be applied when transferred to another. ASSIST is the official repository of articulation for California's public colleges and universities and provides the most accurate and up-to-date information about student transfer in California.

There are two ways to look up information in ASSIST.

#### Explore Transfer Information

If you have already chosen a major or know what kind of information you want to see, select the transfer information you want to display by choosing an institution below. You can select the institution you are transferring from or to.

As a Sociology major transferring to SSU, Soc 1 at SRJC would meet the lower division major preparation course of Soci 201 at SSU. By completing Soc 1 at SRJC you would not have to complete Soci 201 at SSU. Four-year universities want students to enter as a Junior having completed as much of their lower division major preparation courses as possible. You may see "Course not Articulated" or "No Articulation Established" which means SRJC does not offer the equivalent course. Please meet with a counselor to discuss the courses you need to complete for your major and general education.
