UC Merced Fall 2020 Transfer Admission Guarantee Tips

When to write a TAG:

- UCM will accept TAGs September 1 September 30.
- Students must also submit the UC admissions application November 1-30.

Eligibility Criteria:

- <u>TAG Not Available for the Following Majors:</u> Critical Race and Ethnic Studies, English, Global Arts Studies Program, Philosophy, Public Health, and Spanish.
- Completed at least 30 UC transferable units at the time they submit their TAG application.
- The student is enrolled full time at a CCC when the TAG is written.
- The student has not received a bachelor's degree from another institution.
- The student is not simultaneously enrolled at a CCC and at a baccalaureate institution when the TAG is written, except if the student is participating in the intercampus cross-enrollment program.
- The student is not working towards high school graduation while simultaneously enrolled at a CCC.
- The student is a former UC student who left the university in good academic standing (with an overall and last term GPA of a at least a 2.0)
- The student is not a former UC Merced student.

TAG Requirements:

- Complete one UC-transferable mathematics course with a grade of C (2.0) or higher by end of fall 2019.
- Complete one UC-transferable English composition course with a grade of C (2.0) or higher by the end of the fall 2019 term
- Complete a second UC-transferable English composition course with a grade of C (2.0) or higher by the end of the spring 2020 term.
- Complete 60 UC transferable units by the end of the spring 2020 term.
- Complete the academic criteria listed below for your major by the end of the spring 2020 term with a grade of "C" or better.
- No unrepeated grade(s) of No Pass, D or F in UC-transferable coursework.
- No more than two total withdraws in major preparation courses.
- By the end of spring 2020, fall 2020 applicants can have no more than one major preparation course where grades of No Pass, D or F were received even if repeated with passing grades.
- Earned a minimum GPA noted below per School.

School of Engineering
