

UC Santa Cruz Fall 2020 TAG Selective Major Criteria



ECONOMICS: Business Management Economics, Economics, and Global Economics

Students must complete the following courses by the end of spring 2020 with a minimum grade of C for each course, and a minimum GPA of 2.8 for the three required courses.

UC Santa Cruz Courses	SRJC Courses
Econ 1	Econ 2
Econ 2	Econ 1
Econ/AMS 11A OR Math 11A OR Math 19A	Math 16 OR Math 1A OR Math 1A

- An AP Microeconomics score of 4 or 5 can substitute for ECON 1.
- An AP Macroeconomics score of 4 or 5 can substitute for ECON 2.
- An AP Calculus AB score of 4 or 5 or an AP Calculus BC score of 3, 4, or 5 can be substituted for Math 11A or Math 19A.

ECONOMICS: Economics/Mathematics

Students must complete the following courses by the end of spring 2020 with a minimum grade of C for each course, and a minimum GPA of 2.8 for the three required courses.

Econ 2	Econ 1
Math 19A	Math 1A

While it is not required for selection, junior-level transfer students are strongly encouraged to have completed lower-division mathematics and statistics courses required for their intended economics major prior to enrolling at UCSC.
